- Keep a copy of the completed Form A and Form B for your school records.
- Return the completed Form A and/or Form B to the relevant Multicultural/ESL consultant.

### FORM A

#### Permanent resident and Australian citizen ESL students only

To be included on Form A students must fulfil *all* of the relevant requirements as listed below.

##### PERMANENT RESIDENTS

Provide all details for ESL New Arrivals students who are permanent residents as identified by Visa Sub-Class on LIST 1 (attached).

This applies to students who:

- have arrived from overseas and are in need of initial ESL instruction and
- have not previously enrolled in any other Australian school or Intensive English Centre.

##### Kindergarten enrolments

Arrived in Australia after **30 April 2003** and have enrolled in your school **between 1 November 2004 and 31 March 2005** (ie within 18 months of arrival in Australia).

##### All other student enrolments

Arrived in Australia after **30 April 2004** and have enrolled in your school **between 1 November 2004 and 31 March 2005** (ie within 6 months of arrival in Australia).

##### AUSTRALIAN CITIZENS

Enter AUST CIT in visa column.

This applies to students who are:

- enrolling for the *first time* in an Australian school and
- come from a *language background other than English* and are in need of initial ESL instruction and
- are in either Category 1 or Category 2 opposite.

##### Category 1

Born overseas to an Australian citizen.

##### Category 2

Born in Australia to an Australian citizen, but *have lived overseas for more than 2 years* prior to enrolment. State length of overseas stay under student's name (e.g. left Australia at the age of 3 months or left Australia on month/year).

### FORM B

#### Temporary visa holder ESL students only

To be included on Form B students must fulfil *all* of the relevant requirements as listed below.

##### TEMPORARY VISA HOLDERS

Temporary visa holders as identified by Visa Sub-Class on LIST 2 (attached).

This applies to students who:

- have arrived from overseas and are in need of initial ESL instruction and
- have not previously enrolled in any other Australian school or Intensive English Centre.

##### NEW ZEALAND CITIZENS

For New Zealand Citizens holding a valid New Zealand passport without a visa label, enter TY (Class) and 444 (Sub-Class).

##### Kindergarten enrolments

Arrived in Australia after **30 April 2003** and have enrolled in your school **between 1 November 2004 and 31 March 2005** (ie within 18 months of arrival in Australia).

##### All other student enrolments

Arrived in Australia after **30 April 2004** and have enrolled in your school **between 1 November 2003 and 31 March 2005** (ie within 6 months of arrival in Australia).

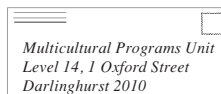
